Schooling until February Half-Term

All pupils will have lessons online until February half-term.

- The children of key workers and vulnerable pupils will be able to attend school. **Please let us know (via email) if you need your child to attend school.**
- Pupils will follow their usual timetable from home (online via MS Teams).
- Please ensure that your child logs on punctually for all lessons from 8.30am. Registration will take place at 8.25am.

Leaving Home

The Government announced the following restrictions this evening for everyone:

- You must not leave, or be outside of, your home except where necessary.
- You may leave the home to:
 - shop for basic necessities, for you or a vulnerable person
 - go to work, or provide voluntary or charitable services, if you cannot reasonably do so from home
 - exercise with your household (or support bubble) or one other person, this should be limited to once per day, and you should not travel outside your local area.
 - meet your [support bubble](#) or [childcare bubble](#) where necessary, but only if you are legally permitted to form one.
 - seek medical assistance or avoid injury, illness or risk of harm (including domestic abuse).
 - attend education if you are a vulnerable child or the child of a critical worker.

If you have any queries or concerns, or need support in any way, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
